

Sliding-Scale Session Fee Guide

Our sliding-scale fee structure ensures that quality mental health support remains accessible to everyone, regardless of financial circumstances. This transparent pricing model is designed to align with your household's unique financial situation, taking into account both your total household income and the number of people you're supporting.

To determine your session fee, simply locate your annual household income in the left column, then find the corresponding range based on your household size. We've created three categories to reflect different family compositions: smaller households (1–2 people), medium-sized households (3–4 people), and larger households (5 or more people). The fee structure acknowledges that larger households typically face greater financial demands and adjusts accordingly.
